Marriage Guidelines



Let Bethany assist you in planning your wedding.





The Session and Congregation of Bethany United Church adopts as its understanding of the covenant of Christian Marriage the following statement:

(From the Marriage – United Church of Canada Understanding- 2005)

Marriage is a union in which the covenant relationship can be expressed and mutually experienced. This will be a relationship of equal partners who freely choose willingly, gladly, and completely to entrust themselves to each other and to be in relationship with each other. The love we offer the other in this covenant is God's gift to us. We are able to love because we are first loved by God.

Marriage in our understanding is grounded in Love: God's love for humanity; love between life partners who seek to live in relationships based on trust, mutuality, and commitment. It is also about the love of caring communities —families, friends, churches-that acknowledge, support, nurture, challenge, and honour such relationships.

In the light of this understanding of the Covenant of Marriage, the Session of Bethany United Church, on the recommendation of Session Executive, adopts the following guidelines for conducting marriages in the sanctuary of Bethany United Church by its lead minister:

 That all persons seeking to be married at Bethany United Church will meet with the lead minister, and other governing church leaders as deemed appropriate for the purpose of reflection on the meaning of marriage of Christian marriage and discipleship.



Arranging the Date - Couples are asked to call (902 455-0521, ext. 222 or Press 1) to arrange a meeting with the lead minister. At the first meeting the suggested date and time will be discussed and may be booked with Ministry Resource Support staff.

<u>Licenses-</u> In order to be married you must obtain a Marriage License. Please arrange to obtain it well in advance of the date of the wedding. It can be obtained at City Hall or various locations, and once issued, is valid for three months. The license must be delivered to the office at least <u>two weeks</u> before the ceremony.

Music - When a wedding date has been confirmed, the Church Organist should be contacted. This should be at least <u>four</u> weeks, before the wedding. All music in connection with a wedding must be appropriate to the Christian service of worship. Generally speaking, this means that music in its entirety expresses faith in God and the implications of that faith in our human relationships.

<u>Photographs</u> – <u>Photographs and</u> <u>video</u> may be taken during marriage <u>ceremony</u> by designated photographer or videographer at the discretion of the presiding minister.

<u>Decorations</u> – Arrangement for delivery of flowers or decorations must be made with our Host or other designated ministry or lay staff. When decorating church pews or other wooden structures, no thumbtacks, nails or staples may be used.
